FREQENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ON THE ASSIGNMENTS

- 1. What are the components of the Lyceum Assessment Strategy ?
 - Students must complete two assignments (one Multiple Choice Question assignment and one Application-Based assignment) and one examination in their registration cycle.

2. How are the assignments and examination weighted in the final grade?

• The two assignments together account for 60% of the final grade (each assignment is 30%), and the examination contributes 40%.

3. Where can I find my application-based assignment?

 All assignments can be found on the specific module pages on myClass on the myLyceum portal. Both the question paper and the blank answer book can be downloaded from the portal for you to complete.

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4. Where should assignments be completed and submitted?

• All assignments must be completed and submitted on myClass on the myLyceum portal. Emailed assessments will not be accepted or graded.

5. What are the new changes to the Assessment Strategy from 2024?

 From 2024 onwards, students must complete both assignments to be eligible to write the examination. Completing only one assignment will result in ineligibility to sit for the exam.

6. What happens if a student only completes one assignment?

• Students who complete only one assignment will not be allowed to sit for the exam and will need to re-register for the module and complete it again.



- 7. Are there any exceptions to the rule of submitting assessments via myClass?
 - No, there are no exceptions. All assessments must be completed and submitted through myClass on the myLyceum portal.
- 8. What is the policy on emailed assessments?
 - Emailed assessments will not be accepted or graded under any circumstances.

9. Will there be any flexibility in the enforcement of these new changes?

• No, the changes to the Assessment Strategy will be implemented strictly from 2024 onwards, with no exceptions.
