Update to the Lyceum Assessment Policy 2024

As we approach the beginning of the assessment submission period, we would like to remind all students of the Lyceum Assessment Strategy that was implemented in 2021 and the new changes that will be instituted from 2024.

Lyceum's Assessment Strategy for assignments includes the following:

- All students <u>must</u> complete two assignments <u>and</u> one examination in their cycle of registration.
- 2. Assignments comprise of one (1) Multiple Choice Question (completed in myClass), and one (1) Application-Based assignment that is uploaded on myClass on the student portal.
- 3. The two assignments (formative assessments) have a weighting of 60% (in other words, each assignment counts 30% towards the final grade). The examination (summative assessment) has a weighting of 40% toward your final grade.

As from 2024, the Assessment Strategy will be implemented strictly. As returning students have had a few years to adjust to the new assessment processes, the College can now become more stringent in its enforcement of the strategy. As such, for the May 2024 examination students and onwards, students:

1. **MUST** complete **BOTH** assignments (Multiple Choice Questions and Application-based assignment) to be eligible to write the examination.
